Genetically Modified Organisms (Control of Release) Ordinance

(Cap. 607) is now in effect

Under the Ordinance, any person who knowingly grows unapproved genetically modified crops in a field commits an offense.

To protect the local biodiversity, growers should avoid planting seeds or other propagation materials (e.g. tuber and rhizome) obtained from the imported agricultural produce of unknown sources and purchase seeds or seedlings from reputable suppliers.
