Codes of conducts for visiting mangroves

- 1. Do not dig-up the sand, mud and rubbles
- 2. Do not overturn stones and boulders
- 3. Do not hunt or disturb any marine wildlife
- 4. Do not stand or trample on the root and seedlings of mangrove and seagrasses (which usually grow along the offshore margin of mangrove site)
- 5. Do not collect any live or dead specimens (photos or video taking are recommended)
- 6. Do not littering, take away your rubbish
- 7. Observe wetland quietly
- 8. Do not pollute mangrove substrate and water bodies
- 9. Respect our marine environment
