Notes for Guidance

1. This certificate is specified to certify that the puppy concerned is born from the bitch which is covered by a valid Dog Licence issued in Hong Kong.
2. Identification of the bitch (microchip) and its Dog Licence issued by Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) must have been verified before any entries are made on the certificate.
3. This certificate must be positively correlated to the animals being certified by inclusion of the identifying microchip details.
4. This certificate caters for one puppy only and is valid until the puppy is 5 months of age.
5. This certificate must be signed by a Veterinary Surgeon registered under the Veterinary Surgeons Registration Ordinance (Cap.529 Laws of Hong Kong).
6. To facilitate proper certification, this certificate provided by AFCD should be used. Veterinary surgeons may approach any of the Animal Management Centres (AMC) of AFCD (addresses and telephone numbers are available at AFCD website: www.afcd.gov.hk) to request for copies of the relevant forms or download them from AFCD website.
