Professor SHAW Pang-chui

- Professor SHAW Pang-chui is the Professor and Director of Biochemistry Programme, School of Life Sciences, Chinese University of Hong Kong. His research interests cover structure-function studies of pharmacologically important proteins, and authentication, quality control and pharmacological studies of Chinese medicinal material. He served as a member of the ESAC from October 2001 to September 2006.
