5. Grants will be awarded to deserving candidates whose academic results are average or above and on a financial need basis. Applicants are required to submit the Declaration of Family Financial Circumstances and the other related documents.

[Note: In general, applicants should pass at least 5 subjects at their recent school examinations, including both Chinese Language and English Language. Applicants' conduct at school will also be considered.]

6. Students applying for scholarship may also apply for grant.

7. The recipient of scholarship/grant must undertake to repay, if required, the awards if his/her work or conduct during his/her study is considered unsatisfactory or if he/she withdraws from the study for whatever reason.

[Note: If the recipient is under the age of 18 at the time of receiving the scholarship/ grant, the undertaking must be countersigned by his/ her parent or guardian.]

- 8. The recipient must follow the approved course of study and abide by the rules of the school in which he/she studies.
- 9. An award may be terminated at any time for reason of unsatisfactory conduct, for breaches of the conditions of award or for failure to make satisfactory progress.
