

**Preventive measures against COVID-19 at the
Endangered Species Resource Centre (ESRC)**

To ensure safety of our visitors in view of the recent situation with regard to COVID-19, we kindly request that visitors of ESRC take note of the following preventive measures:

1. Visitors entering ESRC should undergo temperature checks at the lobby on ground floor of the Cheung Sha Wan Government Office.
2. A sanitizing mat is placed in the lift lobby on the 6/F. Visitors are requested to step on the sanitizing mat to disinfect their shoes before entering the centre.
3. Visitors entering ESRC should observe a series of infection control measures including using the “LeaveHomeSafe” mobile app, showing Vaccine Pass QR codes, wearing their own masks and cleaning their hands with hand sanitiser.
4. On the Open Day of ESRC, the number of visitors at any single time will be limited to 20 to reduce contact with other people. Visitors will be requested to maintain 1.5 metres social distance between each group as instructed.
