1. First-come, first-served basis. Each school can only submit 1 application form to reserve 1 session. Please fax (2667 8212) or email (tpgeopark@taipoea.org.hk) the completed application form to the Association at least a month before the field study. All applications will be preceded until all quotas are filled. All applications will be handled and answered within 3 working days. For any enquiries, please contact us at 2667 0992.
2. Please provide the participant name list to the Association via fax or email a week before the activity day.
3. The field study is an outdoor activity. To comply the safety consideration, this programme is not recommended for any person who is not physically fit.
4. The field study will be mainly conducted in Cantonese. To arrange an English speaking session, please indicate on the application form.
5. Participants are recommended to wear suitable clothing and shoes (e.g. long-sleeved clothing with light color, sports or hiking wear), bring sufficient amount of water and prepare other useful outdoor equipments, such as sunscreen, umbrella, mosquito repellent and etc, on the activity day.
6. Participants should have a self-screening of their physical condition before the field study. If participants are not feeling well, they should not attend the field study and inform the Association immediately. The Association will not be liable to any injury or death which participants suffer in this field study, if the cause of injury or death is due to participants' own negligence or inadequacy in health and fitness.
7. To ensure safety and order, participants must follow the rules and arrangement of the Association. Otherwise, the Association reserves the right to require any participants to withdraw to field study at any time.
8. Participating schools should arrange their own transportation to the gathering point on time.
9. Early leave is not allowed after the commencement of the field study.

10. **Inclement weather:**

a) Thunderstorm Warning, Rainstorm Signal or Tropical Cyclone Signal: The field study will be cancelled if Thunderstorm Warning; Yellow Rainstorm Signal or above; or Tropical Cyclone Signals No.3 or above, is issued by the Hong Kong Observatory 2 hours before the field study starts or during the field study.

b) Inclement weather: The field study will be cancelled even if the above signals are not hoisted by the Hong Kong Observatory when the territory is under unstable weather condition such as heavy showers and squally thunderstorms, interpreter will inform participants of the cancellation 2 hours before the field study starts or during the field study.
