1. Naturalness (15%)	● The site is ecologically important because of the freshwater wetland (pond / marsh) there, which is man-made.	1	0.15
2. Habitat diversity (15%)	● The site comprises two major habitat types, i.e. freshwater wetland (pond / marsh) and woodland.	2	0.30
3. Non-recreatability (10%)	● The ecologically important freshwater wetland, which is abandoned agricultural land and man-made, and is considered easy to be recreated.	1	0.10
4. Species diversity & richness (30%)	● Supports moderate diversity (20% < diversity \leq 50%) of dragonfly (23 species, 21%).	2	0.60
5. Species rarity/endemism (30%)	● Supports the endemic Hong Kong Paradise Fish <i>Macropodus hongkongensis</i> .	2	0.60
