**Notes to Participants**



## I. Objectives

The Competition is organised by Hong Kong Wetland Park, Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (the "organiser") with a view to promoting the rich diversity of wetland species through creative art works. It aims to raise students' awareness on wetland conservation. After the preliminary (Phase I) selection, the best 20 entries from each category will be eligible for public voting on the internet. The top three highest votes of each category will be used to make Wetland Conservation E-cards for sharing and conveying the messages on wetland conservation.

## II. Entry Requirement

Holder of valid Hong Kong student ID card.

## III. Competition Date and Time

11:00a.m. to 4:30p.m on 4 November, 2006

## IV. Application method

1. Teacher should fax or send the school enrollment form to the organiser on or before 28 October 2006. Individual participants (students) are required to get the individual enrollment forms from teachers and bring it along with their student ID cards or student handbooks to the registration counter in the Visitor Centre on 4 November, 2006 from 10:30a.m. to 12:30p.m. for registration. After registration, they will receive a drawing or painting paper.
2. Please return the following documents on or before 4:30p.m. on 4 November, 2006 to the registration counter:
  - a. Completed and signed individual enrollment form
  - b. Completed drawing or coloured graphic.

NOTE: Please fill in the enrollment form in BLOCK LETTERS. All information in the form is mandatory. Failure to provide required information or provide insufficient or incorrect information may influence the processing time and the outcome of your application.

## VI. Theme of Works

Participants have to visit Hong Kong Wetland Park on 4 November, 2006 in person and focus on the vitality of wetland wildlife. The works emphasise in originality and can be in any style of drawing, for examples water-colour or sketches.

## VII. Rules

**Drawing Competition** – Participants should bring their own drawing kits and work on the paper provided by the organiser.

**Colouring Competition** – Participants should bring their own paints and coloured the graphics provided by the organiser.

- NOTE: 1. Participants from kindergarten and primary schools should be accompanied by parents, guardians or school teachers.
2. Each participant could only take one drawing paper or one graphic.

The result will be announced in December 2006 and the winners of each group will be informed by letters.

The organiser reserves the right to call off the Competition in the event of adverse weather conditions or other incidents beyond the control of the organiser. The admission fee is non-refundable.

## XV. Personal Data Collection Statement

The personal information collected will only be used for, but not limited to, the activity related to Hong Kong Wetland Park and will be kept strictly confidential. If you need to check or amend any personal details, please write to Hong Kong Wetland Park and quoted the name of the competition on the letter or envelope cover.

## XVI. Points to be noted and Declaration of the organiser

1. Each participant can only participate in one category and submit only one work.
2. Works that have been rewarded in any past competitions will not be accepted.
3. Works submitted for this Competition will not be returned.
4. The organiser has the right to publish or exhibit the works submitted by the participants for other uses in relation to promote wetlands conservation.
5. The organiser has the right to disqualify any prize winners with any reason.
6. All the terms and conditions are subject to alternation without notice. The organiser has the right to alter all the terms and conditions of this competition.
7. By signing on the enrollment form, the participant agrees to abide by the terms, conditions and rules, to release the organiser, unconditionally, any legal liability for publishing his or her works submitted and undertakes all compensation to the organiser any loss caused by breaching of rules in his or her part.
8. People who are related to the organiser are prohibited from taking part in the competition.

## XVII. Regulations

1. Participants should follow the instructions and carry out the activities in the designed locations instructed by the organiser.
2. No damaging or disturbing wildlife or habitats in the Wetland Reserve is allowed. Please follow the Country Codes stated in Hong Kong Wetland Park.
3. All the participants should keep Hong Kong Wetland Park clean. Contamination on the Park facilities or water bodies is straightly prohibited.
4. Any violation on the above rules would lead to disqualification and possible prosecution under the Country Parks and Special Areas Regulation or any ordinance under the Hong Kong Special Administration Region. Parents/guardians/ person-in-charge of the organization should guarantee and take the responsibility that the participants understand and follow the above rules.
