## Enhancement Measures

for Recreational Fishing Rafts







## Introduction (C)



To promote the development of leisure fisheries, recreational fishing rafts are permitted to sell specific food and beverages without requiring a food licence, provided that these activities do not impact fish culture operations or the environment within designated fish culture zones. The measures aim to diversify recreational fishing experiences while creating additional income for mariculturists.

## Guidelines for the Sale of Specific Food and Beverages on Recreational Fishing Rafts

Licensees with a valid Recreational Fishing Consent Letter ("Consent") are allowed to sell specific food and beverages on the fish rafts in accordance with the Conditions specified in the Consent.


The specific food and beverages include:

Pre-packaged pre-cooked dim-sum

Pre-packaged snacks / candies /nuts / preserved fruit

Pre-packaged biscuits / cakes / bread

Unpeeled and uncut fruits



 Licensees are allowed to have a microwave oven and an electric kettle on the fish raft for visitors' use



 Licensees are only allowed to sell the food and non-alcoholic beverages specified on the list





 Recreational fishing and food and beverage sales operations shall be confined the to the area delineated on the recreational fishing floor plan



 Licensees should store the specific food and beverages for sale properly, including but not limit to the installation of appropriate freezer for pre-packaged cooked frozen foods



 Licensees should provide clean drinking water and disposable tableware during the operation of specific food and beverage sales on the fish raft





 Licensees and operators are prohibited from cooking for visitors
