Following no less than 40 days of destocking period afterwards (destocking period means the period during which no pigs is being kept in the pig farm, which should last for at least 40 days with reference to the European Union), the concerned pig farm has introduced a small number of sentinel pigs to detect any potential residue of ASF virus. The sentinel pigs were then monitored for no less than 30 days. During and at the end of the monitoring period, AFCD Veterinary Officers inspected the sentinel pigs and revealed no abnormalities on the animal health condition. Several rounds of samples were also collected from all the sentinel pigs for ASF testing, which were all tested negative. Subsequently, AFCD issued the "Notice of the Lifting of Infected Place Declaration" to the concerned pig farm on 14 May 2021 and allowed it to commence restocking of pigs.
