OMAN

Withdrawal of a recommendation to suspend trade

1. The Secretariat hereby informs Parties that the recommendation to suspend commercial trade in specimens of CITES-listed species with Oman is withdrawn with immediate effect.
2. In Notification to the Parties No. 2024/032 of 2 February 2024, the Secretariat informed Parties of the recommendation by the Standing Committee that all Parties suspend commercial trade with Oman until further notice.
3. Following the adoption of an additional legal instrument, the Secretariat concludes that the recommendation to suspend commercial trade can be withdrawn since the national legislation of Oman now meets the requirements under [Resolution Conf. 8.4 \(Rev. CoP20\)](#) on *National laws for implementation of the Convention*. The legislation has therefore been placed in Category 1 under the CITES National Legislation Project. <https://cites.org/eng/parties/country-profiles/om/compliance-status>
